



## **Sedalia School District Foundation Mini Grant Information Sheet**

The mission of the Sedalia School District Foundation is to provide financial resources to stimulate learning opportunities for students, teachers, staff, and members of the community. Mini Grants are designed to enhance curriculum and to provide for needs not customarily met by district budgeting/funding procedure.

**Grant application submissions for the 2018-2019 school year will be divided into two grant periods – Fall and Spring Semester. Awards for Fall semester will be announced in December 2018, Awards for Spring Semester will be announced in May 2019.**

Grant recipients will be responsible for completing request vouchers and submitting them to the district Central Office. Fall Semester Grant request vouchers not received prior to June 30, 2019, and Spring Semester Mini Grant December 31, 2019, for Spring semester will become void and grant funds will be forfeited.

A detailed supply/equipment needs list should be included with grant applications, however, due to price fluctuations and exact product availability, winning grant applications will be awarded based on dollar amounts.

*For example; a grant that requested 10 widgets at a cost of \$100 each was awarded, but when the recipient ordered the widgets they actually cost \$150, the grant award will be for \$1,000, not 10 widgets.*

### **Criteria:**

- **Fall Semester Grant deadline is October 31, 2018**
- **Spring Semester Grant deadline is March 31, 2019.**
- Any Sedalia #200 staff member is eligible to make application.
- Applicants are required to have made a monetary contribution to SSDF either directly or through the Payroll Contribution program, or be a “Friend of the Foundation” or “Alumni” Member. Contributions of any amount and/or memberships submitted with this application will qualify and be accepted.



- Mini Grants should be innovative and creative in nature. Grant requests for reusable materials/supplies will be given priority, but Mini Grants may not be used for textbooks.
- Mini Grant applications may be discussed with district administrators for clarification or to explore other funding options.
- Equipment, software, hardware, furniture, or other tangible items, as well as all documentation funded by or written for this grant remain the property of Sedalia School District #200.
- Mini grant recipients will be expected to submit follow up photos or video and information on how the grant funds were implemented in the classroom. The Foundation will possibly use these in the CONNECTIONS newsletter, on our website and social media accounts, in press releases to the media, and in other information provided to donors. It will be the responsibility of the teacher to make sure students in photos or videos have the district photo/media release form on file.

## Instructions for submitting Mini Grant Application

- Cover Sheet, Application, and Budget may be submitted electronically or printed and mailed with completed Cover Sheet on top. Hand-written applications will not be accepted.
