Dual Credit Scholarship program funds classes at State Fair Community College for Sedalia School District #200 juniors and seniors

With funding from the Sedalia School District Foundation, 53 students have been awarded \$11,826 in Dual Credit Scholarships since 2010. The scholarships pay the tuition at State Fair Community College for one college-level course for which students receive both college and high school credits. Students must be a junior or a senior at Smith-Cotton High School. Selection is based on GPA, attendance rate and a written essay.

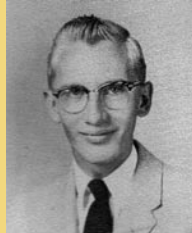

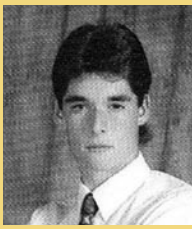
